

## Between Oakland University and Henry Ford College For a Bachelor of Social Work

- Completed the Associate in Arts Social Work and Counseling (transfer option) at Henry Ford College. SWK 131 requires a grade of B or better.
- Complete MTA. It is highly recommended that students complete MTA before transferring to OU. Students who choose not to complete the MTA will be required to complete any outstanding General Education requirements upon transferring to OU. This may require additional credits. MTA course suggestions are below:
  - BIO 131 Introduction to Biology (Natural Science Category), BIO 134 Essentials of Anatomy and Physiology, or BIO 152 Cell and Molecular Biology.

Students who do not complete the MTA must complete OU's General Education Requirements. The following courses are required for admission into the Social Work program and should be included in the course selection if not completing MTA: POLS 131, and BIO 131, BIO 134 or BIO 152.

Associate in Applied Science – Social Work and Counseling (transfer option) Total Credits

### Taken at HFC: 60

- Complete the following additional requirements outside the Associate in Arts Social Work and Counseling (transfer option). This may require a 5<sup>th</sup> semester at Henry Ford:
  - POLS 131 Intro to American Government and Politics (if not completed as part of MTA or additional coursework) – 3 credits

### Minimum take at HFC: 66

- Upon completion of the Associates in Arts Social Work and Counseling (transfer option) students will satisfy the following major courses at Oakland University:
  - SW 2301 Introduction to Social Work (requirement for admission into the social work program)
  - SW 3203 Fundamentals of Social Work Practice
  - SOC elective co-requisite requirement for the BSW Program

#### **Bachelor of Social Work Admissions Criteria**

- A 2.8 GPA is required for admission to the Social Work program. Students must have a minimum cumulative transfer GPA of 2.5 to transfer to Oakland University.
- 56 credit hours completed
- Completion of all necessary program prerequisite courses:

SOC 1000: Intro to SOC with a grade of C or better (SOC 131 at HFC)

PSY 1000: Intro to PSY with a grade of C or better (PSY 131 at HFC)

PS 1100: Intro Political Science with a grade of C or better (POLS 131 at HFC)

BIO 1002/BIO 1200: Human Bio with a grade of C or better (BIO 131, BIO 134, or BIO 152 at HFC)

SW 2301: Intro Social Work with a letter grade of B or better (Satisfied per Agreement)

- Aptitude for the profession of social work including a commitment to social justice, emotional stability and the capacity to build helping relationships with others, and respect for diversity.
- Suitability for the profession as evidence through work or volunteer experience.

#### **Articulation Agreement Notes:**

- All courses that satisfy MTA requirements, as well as OU's major requirements, must be completed with a grade of "C" (2.0) or higher.
- A minimum of 32 credits at the 3000-4000 level must be taken at OU. Consult with a College of Arts & Sciences adviser from OU to confirm the transferability of the electives.
- A minimum of 45 credits must be completed at OU to fulfill the institution's residency requirement to earn a Bachelor's Degree
- Students who complete all 3 Psychology courses within the Articulation Agreement will have the CAS Exploratory requirement of 12 credits outside the major subject code waived.
- Students who opt out of this agreement will be subject to a re-articulation of credits and College of Arts and Sciences policies regarding the exploratory requirement
