Notes:

- 120 total credits to complete OU Bachelor of Science in Applied Health Science degree. A minimum 36 credit hours need to be completed at OU where 32 of the 36 credits are at the 3000-4000 level.
- The Knowledge Applications General Education requirement is automatically completed if pursuing the Leadership Track. When choosing the Health Promotion Track please meet with an academic adviser at OU to determine if it's best to take this requirement at OU or at OCC.
- Submit official transcripts showing AAS degree and all coursework completed with a minimum 2.0 GPA.
- Concurrent enrollment in a community college AAS program and Oakland University's AHS program is not permitted.
