

Between Oakland University and Macomb Community College
For an Associate in Speech Communication Arts to a Bachelor of Arts in Communication

Credits completed at Macomb Community College before transfer

- Associates in Applied Science in Speech Communication Arts
- MTA - It is highly recommended that students complete MTA before transferring to OU. Students must complete **ENGL 1190 or ENGL 1220**.
 - It is recommended students complete the Knowledge Application Gen Ed requirement at MCC. A list of approved courses can be found using the MCC [General Education Transfer Guide](#). Students who do not complete the Knowledge Application equivalent will need to complete the course at OU.

Upon completion the following will be satisfied at Oakland University

- COM 1000 Introduction to Communication Studies (SPCH 1010) – 3 credits
- COM 2000 Public Speaking (SPCH 1060) – 3 credits
- Distribution courses satisfied – 8 credits (2 of the 4 courses below are used to satisfy the Distribution course requirements for the major).
 - COM 2201 Argumentation and Debate (SPCH 2550) – 4 credits
 - COM 2400 Relational Communication (SPCH 2100) – 4 credits
 - COM 2403 Group Dynamics and Communication (SPCH 1200) – 3 credits
 - COM 2702 Performance Communication (SPCH 2800) – 4 credits

Students must complete the following at Oakland University

- COM 3300 Communication, Culture and Belonging – 4 credits
- One Theory Course (COM 3000, COM 3002, COM 3201, or COM 3202) – 4 credits
- Capstone (COM 4950 or COM 4970) – 4 credits
- Complete at least eight (8) additional COM credits at the 3000 level or above, at least four (4) of which must be at the 4000 level
- Additional coursework as needed to complete Communication Degree and University undergraduate graduation requirements. Credits will be determined by meeting with an OU Academic Advisor.

Credits taken at Macomb Community College: 82

Credits taken at Oakland University: 45

Notes:

- Students need to complete outstanding General Education requirements at OU if they do not choose to complete the MTA.
- A total of 124 credits is required for degree completion (transfer credits and credits completed at OU) – **a minimum of 45 credits must be completed at OU overall and 32 of those credits must be upper-level (3000/4000).**
- [Exploratory requirement](#) for the College of Communication, Journalism & Public Relations states that students must take 12 credits outside of their major subject area.
 - Students transferring to Oakland University will benefit from selecting the Mass Media Concentration within this Associates program.
 - The 2 SPCH courses taken under that concentration will be applied to the Communications Major at Oakland University.
 - The 2 courses required for the Mass Media Concentration may also be applied toward the JMS (Journalism and Media Studies) major.
- Students who do not choose the Mass Media Concentration will still need to fulfill the Exploratory requirement at Oakland University.
