Notes:

- Students who do not complete the MTA, will need to complete OU's <u>General</u> Education requirements.
- 120 total credits to complete OU Bachelor of Science in Public Health degree. Additional credits beyond 120 may be required to complete all general education requirements and major requirements.
- A minimum 45 credit hours need to be completed at OU where 32 of the 45 credits are at the 3000-4000 level.
- Number of required elective credits varies based on core courses completed and are selected with assistance from your academic adviser, based on your career goals, from an approved list of courses. Students must achieve a minimum of 120 total course credits with a minimum of 32 upper level (3000-4000) course credits and satisfy all University degree requirements to graduate.
- Submit official transcripts showing AAS degree and all coursework completed with a minimum 2.0 GPA.
