

Articulation Agreement
Between Oakland University and Oakland Community College
For a Bachelor of Arts in Graphic Design

Effective December 1, 2021 - November 30, 2026

1. Complete Associate Degree in Graphic Design at OCC.
2. Completion of the Associate Degree in Graphic Design will satisfy the following courses required for the Graphic Design bachelor degree at Oakland University:
 - a. ART 1002 Foundations of Studio Art: 2D
 - b. DES 1100 Foundations of Design Craft**
 - c. DES 1150 Foundations of Typography**
 - d. DES 1130 Foundations of Graphic Design
 - e. DES 2230 Graphic Design I
3. The associate degree is 65 credits; however, it is highly recommended to complete OU's General Education requirements before transferring. This can be completed through OU's General Education categories or the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA). If pursuing the MTA, ENG 1520 must be taken as this is a pre-req for upper level writing courses.
