Possess a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 (on a 4.0 scale)

- Submit an official application form and any required documentation (e.g., official college transcripts)
- Fulfill all other admission criteria required of incoming transfer students in accordance with then applicable OU policies and/or procedures, which may be amended from time to time.

Students are required to have at least a 2.0 GPA and a C- or better in their individual coursework to be considered for Admission.
Students who transfer having completed the AABA and have a minimum of 56 credit hours, before enrolling, will enter as having junior class standing at Oakland University.
Final transcripts must also be submitted upon completion of your final semester, showing you have successfully completed an Associate's degree.
