Students pursuing the Pre-Pharmacy concentration may pursue admission to any accredited Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) program. Students may complete their senior year of coursework at this PharmD program and credits earned from those courses will be transferred back to OU in order to satisfy degree requirements. It is highly recommended that students consult an OU adviser to discuss course options and pursuing admission to PharmD programs.

TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Glen Oaks or at the Glen Oaks MTA Approved Courses website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.

Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide (minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA):

ENG 121 <u>and</u> ENG 122 (required prerequisite for coursework at OU) One MTA Approved Social Sciences course

Two MTA Approved Humanities or Fine Arts courses

TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. NOTES:

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Glen Oaks, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their Glen Oaks academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
